We are working our way through the various mission projects that were identified last March.

Next on the list is Market 4 Mission which is scheduled for Saturday, July 31st. That date is still good but the market will be extended through the following week. The date, when chosen, was not necessarily optimum for the market but was a good fit for the church calendar. As we approach the actual event it seems that the end of July is the popular vacation and activity time. The church calendar is now open for the week following so the team is going to staff the market for an additional week in hopes of making it available to more customers.
